

## **DOG First Aid Kit**

- Rubber, latex or latex-free gloves. Do you know how to take off safely?
- **Gauze squares** to control bleeding or clean.
- Rolled gauze (varying sizes) to secure gauze squares in place, bandage a wound or make a temporary muzzle
- Adhesive tape or self-adhering bandage to secure rolled gauze in place
- Styptic powder to control minor bleeding
- Blunt-nosed scissors to carefully remove bandages, cut proper lengths of bandaging materials or safely trim pet fur
- Tweezers to remove debris from a wound
- Tick Remover Tool
- Hydrogen peroxide (3%) to induce vomiting or clean a shallow wound site
- Chlorhexidine (Hibiclens®) to flush cuts and wounds
- Eye wash to flush minor wounds and clean eyes
- **Cold pack** to aid in heat stroke, swollen joints, burns and bee stings
- Antibiotic ointment (Neosporin-type product)
- **Digital thermometer** & lubricating gel
- Dose syringe (needle-less syringe) or eye dropper to administer medications and other liquids
- Antihistamine tablets (Diphenhydramine or Benadryl® - not containing cetirizine, acetaminophen or pseudoephedrine) for bee stings or allergic reactions. Gel Caps are preferred
- Antacid tablets to soothe an upset stomach
- Electrolyte solution to aid in re-hydration and also honey or Karo ® Syrup

- Leash to restrain a pet or devise a figure 8harness or temporary muzzle
- **Towel, blanket, tarp** can be used to cover a pet to maintain body heat and/or elevate
- **Dog First-Aid Handbook** to assist with the important details you need to know.
- Phone numbers of your Veterinarian, nearest Animal ER, Animal Poison Control, helpful neighbors, police and fire departments, utility services.
- Eyeglasses
- Nail Clippers
- Canine-specific Aromatherapy or Rescue Remedy for calming
- **Ziplock Baggie** for treats or biological sample
- Dehydrated pumpkin & Ginger snap cookies
- Species-specific shampoo for decontamination
- **Specific items** (prescription meds, epi-pen, etc.)

## **CAT First Aid Kit**

- Cerenia (antacid prescription only)
- NO PEROXIDE Never induce vomiting!
- Different shaped muzzle
- Stethoscope
- Different nail clippers
- Rescue Remedy (no Aromatherapies)
